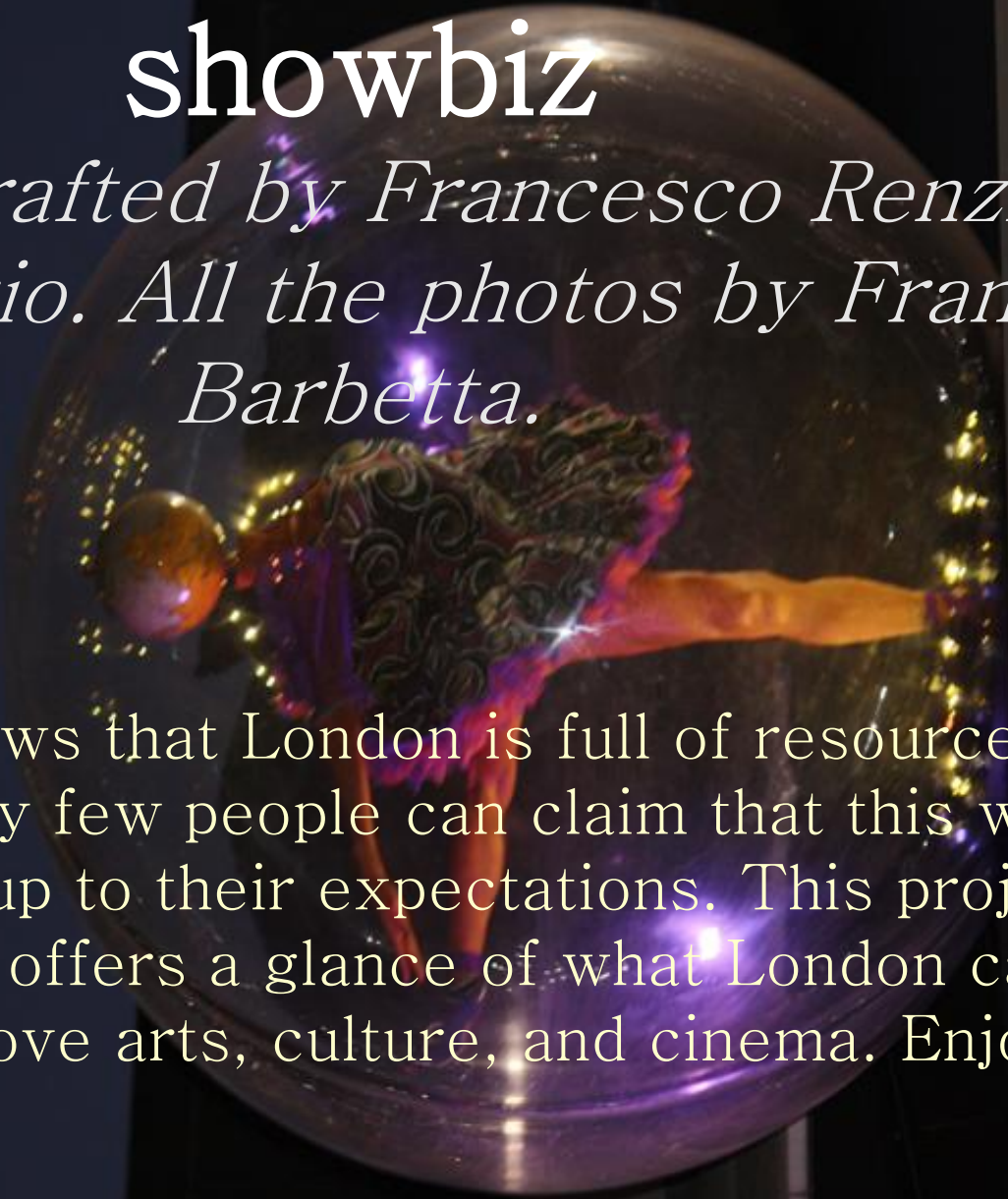


London: art, culture, music and showbiz

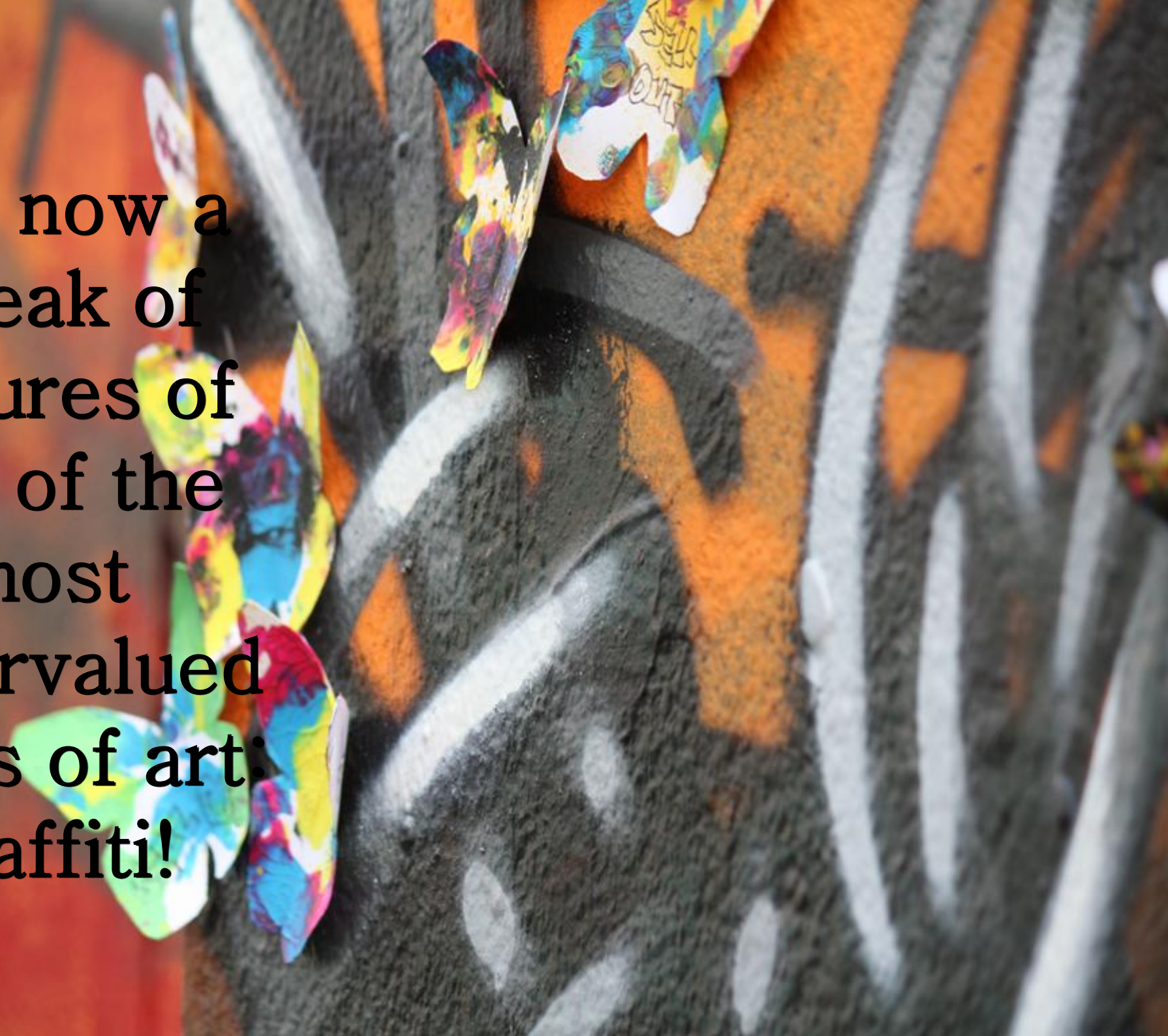

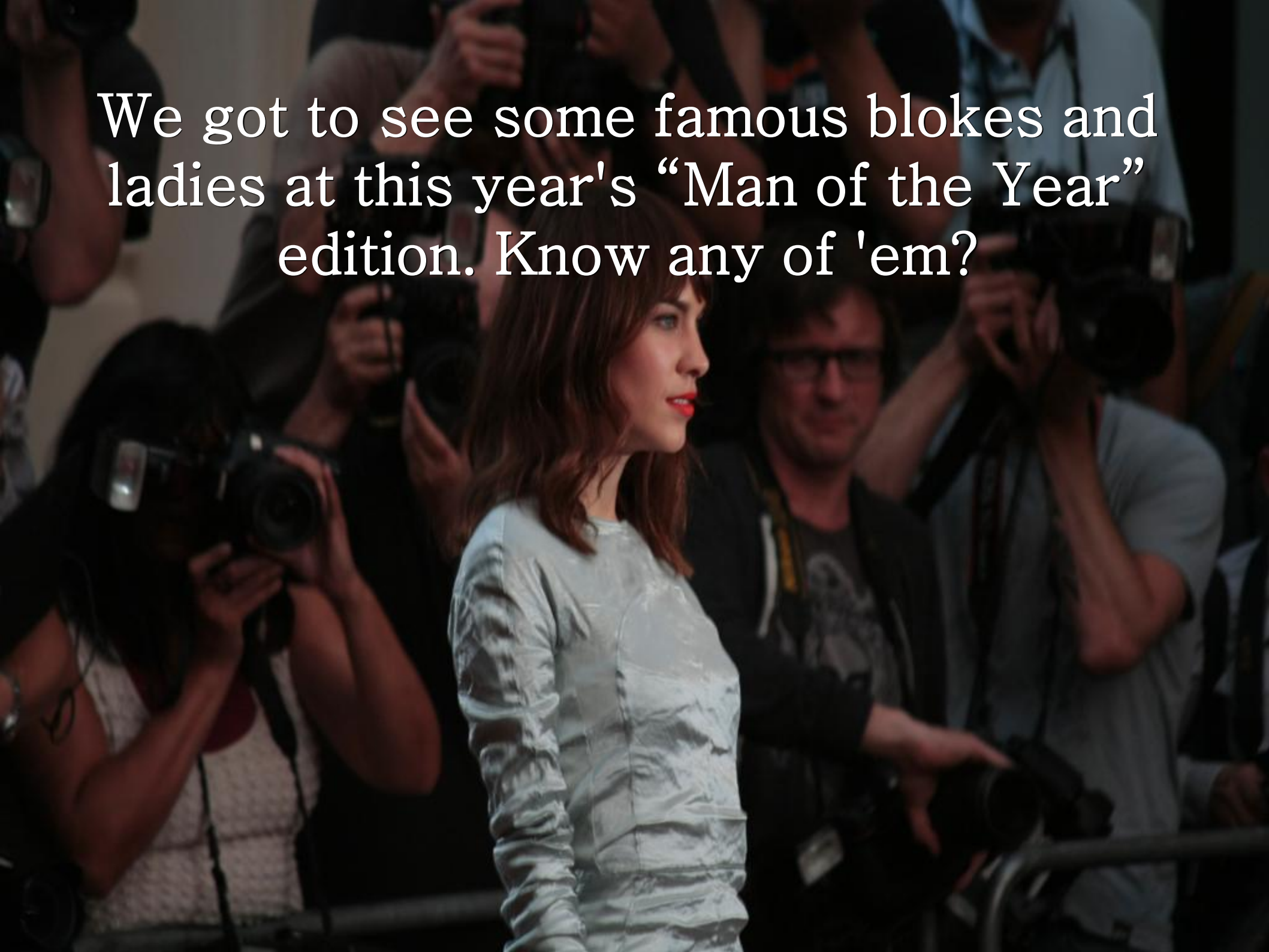
